It is an annual event organised and funded by the Tuscany Region on behalf of the *NECSTouR* network which it presides. It is a network consisting of over thirty European regions with the purpose of ensuring the sustainable and competitive development of tourism.

The Tuscany Region and *NECSTOUR* have always shared the topics and organisation of *Euromeeting* together with the European Commission and the Council of Europe has also been offering an important contribution to the event for several years now, partly as a result of a sort of collaboration agreement.

Every year, the seminar deals with several specific issues concerning the sustainable and competitive development of European tourism and the role that can be played by the European regions in this field.

*Euromeeting* is usually divided into three parts: the introduction which deals mainly with greetings and communications of the European and international institutions; the thematic sessions where topics and issues are developed and analysed; and finally the presentation of good practices and project ideas.
